

Attorney Calendar Conflict UPDATE – 8/22/2011

Due to feedback received from attorneys using the 13th circuit's Attorney Calendar Conflict web application, a new feature has been added that allows a conflict entry for one court (circuit or associate) to be automatically duplicated into the other.

On each of the pages for entry, changing priority, or removing conflicts, a new set of radio buttons will display. The default will be 'ALL COURTS'. If that entry is enabled, then the change made in one court (circuit court, for example) will also be made at the same time for the other court:

Add to Pending Conflict List

This will allow one to enter a conflict once in one court but have it recorded in both courts. If it is desired to have different entries for circuit and associate circuit court, then the other radio button will need to be selected prior to saving the change.

The same radio buttons will be available for changing conflict priority and for removing conflicts.
